

to time not being Inhabitants of this Province shall be permitted upon any termes whatsoever to trade with any Indian or Indians in or through any part of this Province without Speciall licence to be from time to time obtained for the same from the Lord and Proprietary of this Province or his heirs under his or their hand & Seal at armes or his Lieutenant or chief Governour of this Province for the time being under the great Seal of this Province upon pain of confiscacion to the Lord Proprietary and his heirs of all goods and commodities carried and attempted to be sold or which shall be purchased or acquired in or by any such trade or commerce or in case they cannot be seized in specie then the value thereof when any such offence against this act and the true intent and meaning of this clause thereof shall be discovered And when the person or persons so offending or any of his her or their money goods or Chattells shall be apprehended or seized on in any part of this Province

Acts made and enacted by William Stone Esq Governour with the consent of the upper & lower house of Assembly Att a Generall Session thereof held at St Albans on Monday 29th Aprill 1650 as followeth Viz

An Act For punishment of certain offences as Swearing Cursing Audultery &c
 Every person or persons that shall be found or proved by confession of either party to have committed audultery or Fornication such offenders shall be censured or punished as the Governour and Council or other chief Judge and Commissioner present in Court thereunto authorized not extending to Life or member
 Shall a Judge & thinke fit every person or persons inhab:
