Amnapolis the 8th day of May in the Seventh

were Enacted these following Laws

An Act for setting Ammarundell
County Court at the porte of An-
napolis within the same County.

Forasmuch as there is not any good Court house
built and fitted for the County of Am Arundell, and
That the Provinciall Court is now by Law Established to
be hold and kept for ever hereafter at the porte of
Amnapolis on the River of Severn within the same
County where there is and ~~is~~ must of Necessity be a
Court house for the publick Service of this Province
which may be sufficient for holding the County
Courts in also and thereby the County saved the Charge
of building a County Court house and the said porte of
Amnapolis propagated and increased Be it therefore
Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties
and with the Advice and Consent of this present Parli-
ament and the Authority of the Same That the
