An Act Impowering the Commission
of the County of Kent to purchase
three Acres of Land whereon to
build a Court-house.

WHEREAS by the Late Division of the County of
Kent there is absolute Occasion for the ease and Convenience of
the Inhabitants thereof that the Said County Court should be
holden at some other place in the Said County than at the former
Court house, and forasmuch as no place is allotted or provided
whereon to build a new Court house for the Said County
Enacted by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by and with
Advice and Consent of this present Generall Assembly and the
Authority of the Same That the Commissioners or Justices
of the Said County shall be and are hereby made & made
into a body politic with sufficient power thereby given
whereby to Enable them to Treat with any person
and Enjoy for ever the use of the Said County.
