

Acts and Orders of Assembly made
 made by William Stone Esq^r Governor with the advice
 and Consent of the upper and Lower house at a General
 Sessions of the said Assembly held at St Marys the Prov^t
 of Maryland the Eleventh day of March Anno Domⁱ 1650
 as followeth viz^t

An Act Concerning the Secretaries and
 Clerks Fees

For a further Addition to the act made the 29th day of
 April last at a former General Sessions of this present Assembly
 touching the Secretaries and Clerks Fees Be it enacted by the
 Lord Proprietary with the advice and Consent of the upper &
 Lower house of this present General Assembly that the Secretary or
 Clerk shall be allowed for every extraordinary or special warrant
 double the fee of an Ordinary warrant together with 8^{oz} Tobacco
 for the Entry thereof and where for the ease and Convenience of the
 Inhabitants of any remote County within this Province the Gov^r
 hath or shall Authorise the Commander of such County for the
 Granting of warrants for Land and the entry of demands warrants
 and Assignments Concerning the same which are and Ought to
 be Entered in the Secretaries Office to whom the fees for the same
 are likewise due and payable the Clerk of the County or any other
 Person employed by such Commander for the Writing entering
 and transcribing or Copying of such demand Warrants and
 Assignments shall be allowed from the Persons employing him
 therein (over and besides the Fees due to the Secretary) the like
 Fees as are payable to the Secretary for such demands Warrants
 Assignments Copies and transcripts unless such Commander
 shall think fit to appoint any abatement therein
