In the presence of whom the Secretary General in the name
of the Lord Proprietary declared his purpose to be
to depart of the said Colonie in the month of June
1646 and then desired the Burgesses to depart to
their own Speakers.

After which came M. John Baseman and M. Bas
Brooke who were hindered by the weather.

M. Henry Cursey upon a request was desired
to stay some time and to send his horse and to send
Richard Preston their Speaker and M. William Broxon
their Clerk.

Then came M. John Gittinge appointed Clerk for the
purpose now for the said Assembly.

The house adjourned till tomorrow
midnight at the Court the
of Evening.
